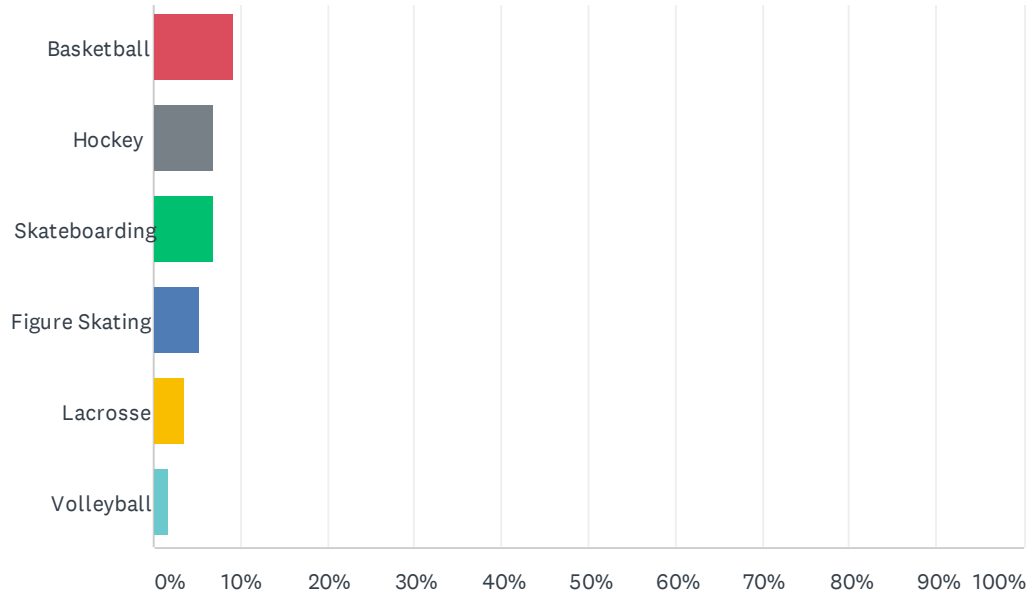

Q4 Do you have a park that you can walk to close to your home? (approximately 1/2 a mile or less)

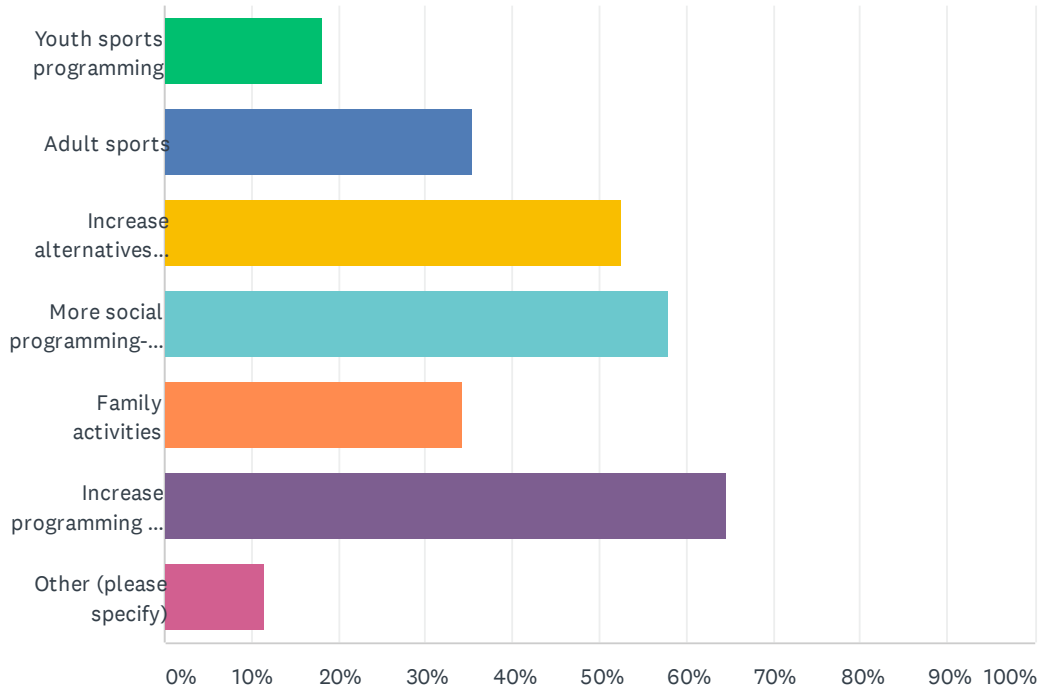

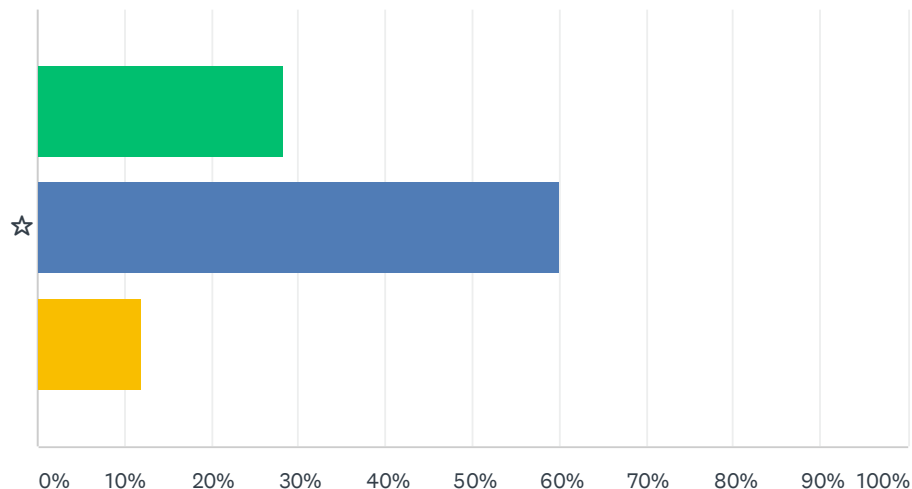

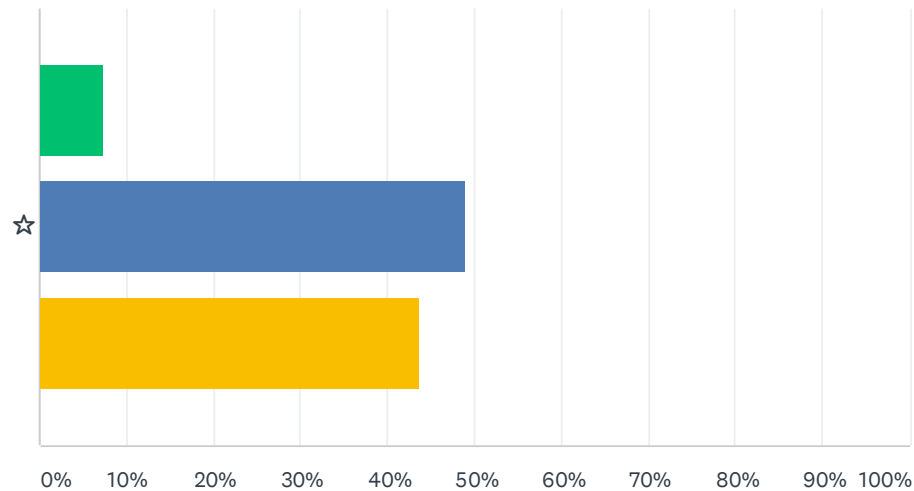
