DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES DRUG INVESTIGATION ARRESTS

DOVER, NH, March 29, 2024- Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that arrests have been made as a result of a drug investigation.

On the evening of March 28, 2024, Dover Police detectives executed a search warrant at 50 New Rochester Road, the residence of 64-year-old Tracey Swett. The operation was the result of a local drug investigation after the department acted upon complaints and information of suspected drug activity occurring at the property.

The investigation resulted in the recovery of approximately 150 grams of cocaine, 100 grams of fentanyl, and \$1600 cash. Tracey Swett was arrested on a warrant obtained by the Dover Police for the Sale of a Controlled Drug; she was further charged with Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute. Both crimes are felony offenses.

Dover Police also arrested Shannon Swett, 45, of 50 New Rochester Road, for Possession of a Controlled Drug, a felony offense.

Both defendants were unable to post bail and are being held at the Strafford County House of Corrections. Their arraignments are scheduled at the 7th Circuit Court—District Division—Dover on March 29, 2024, at 10:00 A.M.

Funding for this investigation was provided in part by the Operation Granite Shield grant. Dover Police were also aided on the scene by the Division for Children, Youth and Families.
