Agreeably to an Act of the Legislature of the State of New Hampshire empowering
the Select men of any Town in said State to make roads & Streets wider and
Straighter.

Therefore we the subscribers from a Complaint of a number of the Inhabitants
of Rochester and other Towns, & seeing cause therefor, do make the following
alterations in the Main Road leading from Dover Landing to Rochester
to wit Beginning on the westerly side of the road at the southeasterly corner
of Samuel Wiggins house on Garrison hill (so called) thence South twenty one
degrees west to Eas^s Samuel Heards land then South nineteen & one half Degrees
west twenty one Rods by said Heards land to Col^o John Waldrons land then
south fifteen & one half Degrees west by said Col. Waldrons to the northeasterly
corner of of Daniel Waldrons field. Then begining North nineteen Degrees
east seven rods from the Northeasterly corner of said Sam^l Wiggins house thence
North fifteen degrees east fourteen Rods thence North ten & one half Degrees east
eight rods & one half & from thence on a straight line to the southeasterly corner






