
Staffing Plan - Fiscal Year 2024 December 12, 2022

The following shows adjustments in the elementary schools and middle school's FTE allocation based on projected enrollment for the 2023-2024 school year.



NEW HAMPSHIRE STUDENT ENROLLMENT TREND




DOVER SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT ENROLLMENT TREND




DOVER HIGH SCHOOL STUDENT ENROLLMENT TREND




DOVER MIDDLE SCHOOL STUDENT ENROLLMENT TREND




DOVER ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS STUDENT ENROLLMENT TREND
