- WHEREAS:** Alex Molda, representing St. Thomas Aquinas High School, entered the 2025 NHIAA Boys State Singles Tennis Championship as the #1 seed, exemplifying excellence, determination, and skill; and
- WHEREAS:** Competing against the top 32 student-athletes from across all divisions throughout the week, Alex delivered a commanding performance, defeating the #7 seed from Kearsarge in the semifinal round 6–0, 6–4, and then capturing the state title with an impressive 6–0, 6–1 victory over the #3 seed from Bedford High School in the championship match at Southern New Hampshire University; and
- WHEREAS:** This marks only the third time in school history—and the first time since 2000—that a St. Thomas student-athlete has claimed the NHIAA Boys Singles Tennis Championship title; and
- WHEREAS:** As a junior, Alex has already achieved 100 match wins at St. Thomas Aquinas and has maintained an undefeated record in singles play throughout team competition, a testament to his consistency, focus, and elite performance; and
- WHEREAS:** Alex’s remarkable achievement, guided by the leadership of Coach Molda, reflects the highest standards of sportsmanship, dedication, and class, and brings great pride to the St. Thomas Aquinas community and the City of Dover;
