EXPLORE THE DOVER COMMUNITY TRAIL

The City's Community Trail runs through the heart of downtown Dover, providing "green" transportation connections for walkers, runners, and bicyclists between Watson Road and Central Avenue. Enjoy 8 roundtrip miles of trail, part of which run along an abandoned railroad, and take advantage of opportunities for snowshoeing, cross country skiing, and bird watching and fishing along the Cochecho River.





TRAIL USE RULES

- The Trail is a City of Dover linear park and all City Park rules apply.
- Please do not litter. The Trail is a "carry-in/carry-out" facility.
- Dogs must be leashed at all times, and owners are required to pick up and dispose of dog waste properly.
- No motorized vehicles except for wheelchairs.
- No fishing from the bridge.
- Bicyclists please yield to pedestrians.
- No possession or use of alcoholic beverages.
- No fireworks or fires.
- No camping.
- Please respect adjoining landowners and stay within trail boundaries.
