#### Site Survey: Pre-production Phase

- Color-Ad's project manager initiates a project site meeting with the City of Dover.
- · All signage locations will be inspected, proactively measured and have pictures taken for seamless planning
- All survey information is recorded for records and as input for shop drawings/manufacture/installation thereon.

#### Shop Drawing/Pre-production Phase (Color-Ad Internal)

- Final digital files, architectural input, survey information, and project specifications are collected and compiled for the entire package with mutually agreed priorities.
- Dedicated project manager working on this project will form his core operational team for this project, comprising of an Auto Cad Designer, Graphic Designer, and Project administrative assistant.
- A meeting is convened between project managers. Auto Cad Designer, Graphic Designer, Production planning and control, Shop floor supervisor, fabrication technician, and Field Operations Manager. Project manager will explain the project in a broader view.
- Copies of the Design drawings and specifications are shared at this meeting for review and to provide collaborative input for shop drawings.
- A new meeting date is agreed to reconvene and discuss the manufacturing methods, any value engineering methods and final shop drawing input. The input is gathered, discussed thoroughly and transferred to the AutoCAD and graphic designers to initiate shop drawings.
- Simultaneously the design input is sent to a qualified structural engineer to evaluate, review and comment on the structural and stability details for all required signage.
- Once the structural details are finalized and approved, they are incorporated into the shop drawings and officially stamped by the engineer.
- Project manager will create a list of submittals required for the project.
- Initiates a shop request to prepare/procure required samples.
- Once the shop drawings are prepared and the samples are manufactured, they will be submitted to the client as per the project requirements.
- It is the project manager's goal to have the drawings approved at first submittal. If the drawings are not approved; the drawings are revised as marked and resubmitted for approval.
- Project Gantt charts are created for the following: (a) project schedule (b) process schedule (c) install schedule.
- A bill of materials and labor is prepared for the project.
- Materials management is requested to obtain final quotes and check on availability of materials.
- PACE department is requested to obtain final quotes and due dates from subcontractors as necessary to comply
  with the schedules and other custom requirements for the project.
- Prepare and submit final work orders to production and installation teams.



#### Project Management Scope (Color-Ad Internal)

- Initiate progress meetings with production, field operations, materials management.
- Mobilize crews.
- Attend required project and site meetings.
- Day to day management of the project include construction progress monitoring
- Billing.
- Project completion-sign off, punch list, maintenance manual, as built drawings, etc.

#### Production

Upon Shop drawing approval the project manager will prepare a thorough work order package, including; approved set of shop drawings, bill of material and labor, quality assurance instructions, packing instructions and project schedule Gantt chart. Work order will be received by the production planning and control manager in production. He will assign a team of fabricators to work on this project. The complete work order package is reviewed, discussed, and a fabrication plan is created based on the project deadline. The available resources are pooled to find the available crews to work (including weekends, if required) to complete the job on time.

Weekly production updates are provided to the project manager. However, the project manager will walk the floor at least two times a day to monitor progress and/or answer any questions from our fabricators.

Samples are proactively sent and all approvals are obtained and establish the approved samples as control samples. Once the elements are fabricated, they will go through our final quality control check/Assurance before final approval is given. If the elements meet all quality standards then the clearance sheet is signed and the elements are packed and crated for shipping.

It is our intent to produce as much as feasible all products at once to maintain consistency in finishes and we will be storing the fabricated signs at our local partner's shop to be able to install the signs based on agreed schedule

Shipping is handled by our materials management department. Depending on the availability of personnel and company moving equipment, we will decide whether or not to contract shipping out (though we prefer to ship our products ourselves in order to preserve the quality of our products).

The shipping crew is briefed with the safety instructions on how to handle the products safely and deliver to the job site without any damages.

#### Installation and Closeout

- Color-Ad's project manager and installation crew will meet on site as per the agreed-upon schedule.
- We will bring all portable power tools necessary to perform almost any task.
- All touch paints and or any finishing tools will be brought to installation to repair any damage to graphics or sprayed finishes which could possibly occur during installation.
- A final walk through will be conducted with the Client/Design Team to note any punch list items. A copy of any punch-list deficiencies will be given to the CM at the end of the walk-thru. Any punch-list deficiencies will be corrected by Color-Ad within a short but reasonable time period.
- The site supervisor, with help from his installation crew, will help demonstrate access to and Cleaning of the installed signs.
- Copies of an operations and maintenance manual will be submitted to the client at the time of final inspection.



Color-ad will also turn over any client-furnished materials.

Warranty and After Warranty Service

Color-Ad, on occasion, has a qualified local sign company/partner to help us, if needed to meet schedule requirements, on the project during the duration of the project as well as warranty period and post warranty period.
