Chief Anthony Colarusso of the Dover Police Department announces that Jeremy S. Jackson, 24, has been arrested in connection with a recent shooting.

The shooting occurred at approximately 11:00 AM on December 12th. Witnesses reported Jackson was involved in an altercation with another man outside a residence on George Street in Dover and pointed a handgun at him. After the man ran away from Jackson, Jackson fired a shot into the residence. Jackson then fled the scene. No one was injured in the shooting.

After an investigation Dover Police Department detectives obtained an arrest warrant charging Jackson with Criminal Threatening, Reckless Conduct, and being a felon in possession of a firearm, all felony charges.


On December 14, 2015 at approximately 6:20 PM Dover Police Department detectives, working with Rochester Police Department detectives and officers from the Strafford County Sheriff's Office Drug Task Force located Jackson in an apartment building at 17 Norway Plains Road in Rochester, New Hampshire. Jackson was arrested without incident.

Jackson refused the services of a bail commissioner and is being held at the Strafford County House of Correction. He is scheduled for arraignment at 10:45 AM on December 15, 2015, in the Seventh Circuit Court – Dover District.
