DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ARRESTS IN DRUG INVESTIGATIONS

DOVER, NH, June 25, 2019 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that two arrests have been made as a result of drug investigations conducted during Operation Granite Shield. Jeremiah Walker, 41, and Cristina Gatzimas, 37, both homeless, have been arrested for Sale of a Controlled Drug, a felony.

The charges are the result of joint investigations conducted by the Dover Police Department and the Strafford County Sheriff's Office. On June 21, 2019 at approximately 10:20 A.M., Walker was arrested at a Dover apartment complex. He was released on personal recognizance and is scheduled to appear in the Strafford County Superior Court on July 5, 2019 at 12:30 P.M.

Gatzimas was also arrested on June 21, 2019, at approximately 2:15 P.M., in the parking lot of a downtown business. She too was released on personal recognizance and is scheduled to appear in the Strafford County Superior Court on July 5, 2019 at 12:30 P.M.
