DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ARRESTS IN ASSAULT INVESTIGATION

DOVER, NH, May 5, 2023 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that an arrest has been made for an assault that occurred earlier in the morning.

On May 5, 2023 at 10:10 A.M., Dover Police responded to 898 Central Avenue for a reported assault involving an edged weapon. At the scene, they found a 49-year-old Dover woman who had several lacerations as a result of an assault. The victim was transported by ambulance to Wentworth-Douglass Hospital where she was treated and released.

The suspect, 51-year-old Lisa K. Perry of Portsmouth, NH, was known to the victim and the motive for the assault appears to be drug related. Perry was located in Portsmouth and arrested in the afternoon of May 5, 2023 by Dover Police detectives. She was charged with First Degree Assault, a class "A" felony.

Perry refused bail and was transferred to the custody of the Strafford County House of Corrections. She will be arraigned in the Strafford County Superior Court on May 8, 2023.
