DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES CHARGES FROM DEATH INVESTIGATION

DOVER, NH, April 3, 2025- Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that an arrest has been made as a result of a death investigation.

On February 11, 2025, Dover Police detectives conducted an investigation into the death of Evan Post, 41, who was found deceased in his apartment at 1 Westgate Drive. Also present at the time was his roommate and companion, Maria Campbell, 37.

Detectives determined that Post had been deceased for several days while Campbell remained in the apartment. A third party discovered the situation and immediately reported it to law enforcement. While the official cause and manner of death are still pending toxicology results from the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, preliminary findings indicate that Post likely died from a drug overdose.

Under New Hampshire RSA 644:7 – Abuse of Corpse, individuals are required to report a death or the discovery of a deceased person to local law enforcement. On April 2, 2025, Campbell was charged with violating this statute, for knowingly failing to report Post's death.

Campbell faces a Class A misdemeanor and is scheduled to appear in the 7th Circuit Court – District Division – Dover on May 5, 2025, at 8:30 A.M.
