DOVER POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES WEAPONS ARREST

DOVER, NH, April 25, 2025 - Chief William Breault of the Dover Police Department announces that David Williams, 46, of 102 Durham Road, Dover, has been arrested.

Williams surrendered to the Dover Police Department on April 25, 2025, at approximately 4:30 p.m., on warrants issued for Criminal Threatening, Felon in Possession of a Firearm, Disobeying an Officer, and Resisting Arrest.

The charges stem from an April 21, 2025 incident in which Williams brandished a firearm during an argument with another individual. Officers located Williams as he arrived at his residence where he fled into his house and then out the rear of the property into nearby woods. Williams was able to escape before a perimeter could be secured.

Since the incident, Dover Police detectives have been investigating all leads and tips regarding Williams's whereabouts. These efforts resulted in Williams agreeing to surrender himself.

Williams refused bail and is being held at the Strafford County House of Corrections. He is scheduled to be arraigned at the 7th Circuit Court – District Division – Dover on April 28, 2025, at 10:00 a.m.
