DOVER POLICE ARREST 4 IN GRANITE SHIELD SWEEP

DOVER, NH, January 15, 2020 - Chief William Breault announces the arrest of several local individuals for drug related offenses. On the evening of January 14, 2020, investigators from the Dover Police Department, the Strafford County Sheriff's Office, the University of New Hampshire Police Department, and the Rowley (MA) Police Department engaged in targeted enforcement of the state's drugs laws and arrested:

- Casey Dyer, 40, 50 New Rochester Road, Dover, NH
Fugitive from Justice stemming from a felony warrant obtained by the Rowley, MA Police for Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute.
- Debra Leavitt, 40, 50 New Rochester Road, Dover, NH
Fugitive from Justice stemming from a felony warrant obtained by the Rowley, MA Police for Possession of a Controlled Drug with Intent to Distribute
- Marc Martin, 42, 26 Addison Place, Dover, NH
Possession of a Controlled Drug with the Intent to Distribute (Felony)
- Cassandra Nickerson, 31, 35 Polly Ann Mobile Home Park, Dover, NH
Possession of a Controlled Drug (Felony)

Both Dyer and Leavitt were held at the Strafford County Jail and are scheduled to be arraigned in the 7th Circuit Court, District Division, in Dover on January 15, 2020.

Martin and Nickerson were released on personal recognizance and are scheduled to appear in the Strafford County Superior Court on January 30, 2020.
