DOVER, NH, December 17, 2020 - The Dover Police Department and the Office of The Chief Medical Examiner are investigating the death of Ainsley-Aude Croteau, 29, of 5 Spring Street, Dover.

At approximately 7:57 A.M. on December 12, 2020, the Dover Police and Dover Fire and Rescue responded to Spring Street after Croteau was found unresponsive. Croteau was found to be deceased by the responding officers and paramedics.

While the cause and manner of the death will ultimately be determined by the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, based on the investigation to date, Croteau's death appears to be drug related.

If in fact this death is due to a drug overdose, it is the eighteenth in Dover in 2020. Dover had nine suspected drug related deaths in 2019.

This case is being investigated by the Dover Police Department's Special Investigations Unit. Anyone with information about this incident is asked to call the Dover Police Department at 603-742-4646.
