Dover, NH, June 21, 2021 - The Dover Police Department is conducting a coordinated investigation with the Strafford County Attorney's Office into a shooting that occurred at a residence located at 42 New Rochester Road.

On June 20, 2021, at approximately 3:41 PM, Dover Police and Dover Fire and Rescue personnel responded to a reported shooting at 42 New Rochester Road. The shooting occurred during a domestic disturbance at a family gathering at the residence.

Dover Police and Dover Fire personnel arrived on scene and discovered a 35 year old male suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. The man was transported to Portsmouth Regional Hospital and subsequently to Boston Medical Center, where he is currently listed in critical condition.

All of those involved in the incident have been identified and at this time there is no threat to the public. At this time no charges have been filed however, the investigation remains active.
